**Re: October 1<sup>st</sup> Request for an Investigation into Premier King**

Dear Commissioner Doiron,

I sent a letter to you on October 1, 2021 asking that you undertake an investigation into a matter pertaining to allegations that Premier King has been using non-government means of communication concerning an online egaming proposal involving Chris LeClair (PolicyIntel) and Keith Laslop (Newco in 2012; Gamesys in 2021) so as to avoid having those activities captured in government documents, which would be accessible through FOIPP.

Sworn affidavits in a lawsuit recently launched against Dennis King et. al., allege that the Premier instructed others to use his non-government email specifically to ensure that Paul Maines, President and CMT (the individual who has launched the lawsuit) and “Dr. Kevin Arsenault,” would not learn about the Premier's discussions on a Gamesys online gaming proposal through FOIPP.

I asked that you acknowledge receipt of my request, stressing the seriousness and urgency of this matter, but have yet to hear from you.

Last Friday, I spoke with Maria McDonald and asked for an update on my request. I was informed that you had received my submission, but she could tell me nothing more than that you were working on it.

With my previous requests, you would immediately acknowledge my communications. With one that I submitted on July 20, you responded on the very same day, and took immediate action on the matter, informing me of the following:

*“I have made an inquiry to APSO, asking them to look at their copy of the package of records forwarded to our office in relation to the review, to confirm that it was not part of the records originally produced in relation to the request. I will get back to you once I have heard back from APSO on my request.”*

It is now coming up on a month since I submitted my request for you to matter described above, and in much more detail in my October 1, 2021 letter, and you have yet to communicate with me on this matter. I am therefore writing to request an update, hopefully with some sense of a timeline and what I can expect on a go-forward basis.
