Dear Rev. Brian,

I just posted the attached advertisement with comments on Facebook.

I had hoped to hear from you by now, following our meeting last Tuesday (December 3rd)....or better still, to have heard from you through a public statement I hoped you would make to stand up for the truth about the evil campaign underway. I've been holding off on additional articles these past few days exposing corruption and complicity with evil within the Catholic Church in PEI, but after seeing how things are continuing to march down the very same road with our church - the same road Catholics in Germany walked some years back before the Nazi reign of terror, only to weep in shame, remorse and regret when the lights finally came on after the war and they were willing to then look at the truth of what they had done (and DIDN'T do).

I'll be resuming that series of articles this week-end, which are being distributed widely throughout the church in PEI and beyond, and is absolutely NOT the route I want to go, but your silence and inaction leave me no choice but to call out this lack of leadership. You may not want to face the truth yet, or pretend that there's always "two sides" to every story - but you were given enough to know how to find the truth, but until you make that choice your complicity continues as does the attack on innocent Island children.

Being a long-time member of the Charismatic movement, and knowing what a good priest you are, giving tireless service to your people, makes your refusal to lead now baffling and sad to me Rev. Brian.

If at anytime you have a change of heart and reach out to me for assistance in strategizing to take action and testify to the truth, in faithfulness to the call of our Lord, to feed the lambs, in defense of the thousands of Islanders being poisoned with a genocidal toxin in a demonic one-world-government war against humanity, then I'll immediately cease writing critical articles and turn all my attention and energy to supporting you in moving forward with what should be happening now....A PROACTIVE, open and fearless public witness by the church to expose the evil of this campaign.

Do you not yet believe that I have evidence - evidence that would stand up in court - for EVERYTHING that I'm saying?

Did I somehow mishear or misunderstand you??? [See attached]. Is there a policy in the Diocese guiding priests on the "we won't segregate our flock" policy you said was the one the Catholic Church would be following?

Or is it the wild west, where priests do whatever they decide at the parish level - either (1) chastising and insulting parishioners based on lies and disinformation in one parish; or (2) telling parishioners the jabs are all part of a mass campaign of lies and to be sure to do their DUE DILIGENCE before getting them: both messages given to Catholics in different parishes on the same Christ the King Sunday?

Can you inform me whether there is a Diocesan policy on the VaxPass, and if so, provide me with a copy? If there is no such policy, and in keeping with what you told me last Tuesday, will you issue a statement to all priests to explain that the Catholic Church will not be requiring VaxPass for ANY church-based activities, worship or otherwise, if they are held in the church or church hall?

Can you also kindly acknowledge receipt of this email and the attached Notification of Liability to save me the trouble of having to drop it off in person?
